Education is the manifestation of perfection already in man.



The Ramakrishna Mission Shishu Vidyamandir, Lumdung, Seppa – 790102, East Kameng, Arunachal Pradesh is an introductory step of the advent of Ramakrishna Mission in the Western half of Arunachal Pradesh. As per the request of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Ramakrishna Mission has agreed to establish a Secondary School on the hilltop at Lumdung. The construction work has started to some extent and the project is stipulated to be completed by 2021. The great historian and Nobel Laureate Sir Arnold Toynbee had said: "The modern world had an western beginning but if it is to survive it must have and eastern end, with special emphasis on Ramakrishna Vivekananda ideology". In fact the outstanding definition of Education that Swami Vivekananda offered to the world is the Watchword of our Educational Institutions and this Primary School is no exception to that.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In the end of June, 2017 the Nanghee Natung Mowa Tocha Welfare Society of Lumdung village, Arunachal Pradesh donated a piece of land to Ramakrishna Mission with an expectation that a Residential Secondary School should start at this place, so as to fulfil a long standing demand of the people of Arunachal Pradesh.

On 30th March, 2018 there was a meeting at Lumdung Govt Secondary School to discuss about the commencement of a Primary School for the time being. The Govt. School Management was kind enough to provide some space to start up a Primary School on temporary basis to be run by the Ramakrishna Mission. Shri Mama Natung, Sri Shishu Natung, Shri Hari Natung, Dr. Tanie Natung along with the District Administration had agreed wholeheartedly to support the noble project if taken up the Mission. It was decided that the Classes for Grade I and Grade II would start in the month of September 2018.

OBJECTIVE

Education, in order to be effective and fruitful, must be 'Man-making': that is, it must bring about total and integrated development of personality of the students. This can be achieved only when the student is brought up in a congenial atmosphere. In this context Swami Vivekananda had prescribed the Gurukula

system of education. The Shishu Vidyamandir is a prelude to adopting this system to supplement the modern conditions of life.

The institution aims at helping the students not only to receive the stipulated academic education, but also to become active, self-reliant and to build up their own characters in keeping with the National Ideals of renunciation and service of our country.

ADMISSION

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IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- Admission Application Form issued by the Shishu Vidyamandir must reach the Principal on or before the stipulated date.
- Students studying in UKG/ CLASS-I are only eligible to appear in the admission test.
- Maximum age for appearing in Class I is 6 (six) years (on 31st March 2020).
- Maximum Height limit of the candidate is 115cm.
- Any chronic disease is held as bar to admission.
- Students found undesirable due to physical unfitness or any harmful habits are liable to be removed even after joining the school.

ITEMS TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE SELECTED STUDENTS:

- Two copies of Passport size photo.
- One copy of Aadhaar card (attested).
- Transfer Certificate from Previous School.
- Date of Birth proof certificate (attested).
- One copy of Caste Certificate (attested).
- One Copy of BPL certificate (attested) if parents belong to BPL Category.





Teaching is primarily conducted through English. But Hindi will be used as a substitute language in case of any individual's problem. In the process of learning importance of Hindi as the National Language, can't be ignored.

Students must attend the school in prescribed and clean uniform with proper hair cut. Students are not allowed to keep Split hair, Pony Tail. Use of Hair Gel and Hair Dye is strictly prohibited. Tattooing the hands and other parts of the body must be avoided. Wearing chains, Ear Rings and Bracelets are not allowed in the school.

STAFF

The Principal/ In-charge of the School is usually Monastic member. He is assisted by efficient staff members, teaching and non-teaching, consisting of monastic and non-monastic members.

EXAMINATION

Individual attention, as far as possible, is given to each student. Continuous evaluation and periodical examinations/ Unit Tests are conducted. Results along

with report on conduct are sent to the guardians usually twice in a year.

For a student who is absent from any test, no provision can be made for supplementary test. Failure to appear any test or examination can seriously affect a student's promotion. Students failed in the Annual Examination will not be promoted to the next higher class in any circumstances.

SESSION, VACATION AND HOLIDAYS

Presently the school session starts in May and End in March. The school observes three vacations namely – Puja Vacation, Winter Vacation and Annual Vacation. A school calendar showing all the holidays is circulated to all the students at the beginning of the session.

FEES AND CHARGES

Education in Class I and II are Free of Cost. But in case of other classes, Parents have to pay Session Charges.

The parents will have to provide School Uniform (to be availed from School Office) and Details of the Transportation Fees will be available at the Office of the Institution. The Transport fees are subject to change from time to time as and when necessary.

ROUTINE

The school starts with Vedic Chanting and National Anthem. Starting of the School is at 8:30 a.m. and closing is at 12 noon. Opening and closing timings of the school is subject to change during the winter (from November to March).

DIET

Every effort is made to provide the children with a wholesome and well balanced diet/ Tiffin. The menu is decided by the School Authority as per the availability of item in the local market.



Needless to say that healthy, well-disciplined and morally strong children are the finest assets of a nation. But the co-operation of guardians is essential to train the children. Discipline is a vital factor in every school. Students can be served more effectively by placing trust in and appealing to their sense of self-respect. Students who have an aptitude for leadership get an opportunity to learn, to take up and carry out responsibilities in a fair and efficient manner. All efforts are made in that direction. In case of any difficulty the concerned student should meet the authority individually.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR & CREATIVE ACTIVITIES

The institution provides ample provision for supplementary education in the form of various activities viz. Music, Drawing, Recitation, Hand Writing Competition etc.

Wall magazines prepared by the students are displayed in the school notice board.

MEDICAL FACILITIES AND HEALTH

As such there is no major Medical Facility in the School. But in case of some minor injury, the School has its own arrangement to get the patient temporarily fit to go to a medical practitioner in the locality or at General Medical Hospital.

TRAVELLING ARRANGEMENTS

School Bus/ Van services will be available from Seppa to Lumdung. Parents from other villages have to arrange the vehicle of their own to drop their wards. Other Parents may arrange their own transport to drop their child at the school and to get him/her back home after the classes. To avail transport facility a printed proforma has to be filled in and transportation fees to be deposited in advance.



WITHDRAWALS

In case of withdrawal of a student or in case of removal by School Authority, only the Security Deposit will be refunded to the Parents/ Guardians.

PAYMENT MODE

Payment should be made either by 'Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque' to be drawn on S.B.I. Seppa in favour of "Ramakrishna Mission Lumdung". In no case payment in cash is encouraged.

IMPORTANT

In matters of dispute of any kind, the decision of The Secretary will be final and binding.
